

Verified Disability Authorisation

You recently contacted us because you are registered disabled and would like this information added to your record on the Housing database.

We offer a concessionary repairs service to people who are registered disabled, but to be entitled to this service you must provide evidence that you are eligible.

Acceptable evidence is

- your blue badge (if you have one)
- **or** a letter from the DWP confirming your Disability Living Allowance.
- **or** another form of evidence from DWP that shows you are receiving Disability Living Allowance.

Letters showing income support entitlement, copies of bank statements or letters from GP's are not acceptable forms of evidence.

Due to the Data Protection Act, to allow us to add this information to your housing record you must complete and sign the attached form and bring this with the original of one of the above acceptable forms of evidence to Access Croydon, Bernard Weatherill House. We will take a copy of your evidence and update your records.
