Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2019 London Borough of Croydon

In accordance with the requirements of the Representation of the People Act 1983, and the Electoral Administration Act 2013, notice is hereby given that the Croydon Council is carrying out a review of polling districts and polling places that are used at parliamentary elections.

Representations are sought from persons who are considered to have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

In addition, any registered elector in Croydon may make representations to Electoral Services on the existing and proposed arrangements. If possible representations should suggest alternative venues for polling places.

Representations should be made in writing to Electoral Services by no later than 2 September 2019.

Details of the current arrangements and the (Acting) Returning Officer's proposals for changes can be viewed at the Electoral Services office, and on the Croydon Council website www.croydon.gov.uk/pollingreview

Details of representations received will be made available for inspection and will be published at the conclusion of the review.

Final proposals for any changes to the existing polling districts and polling places must be agreed at a meeting of Croydon Council, and implemented by 1 February 2020, and the revised scheme of polling stations and polling places will be used at subsequent national and local elections and referendums.
