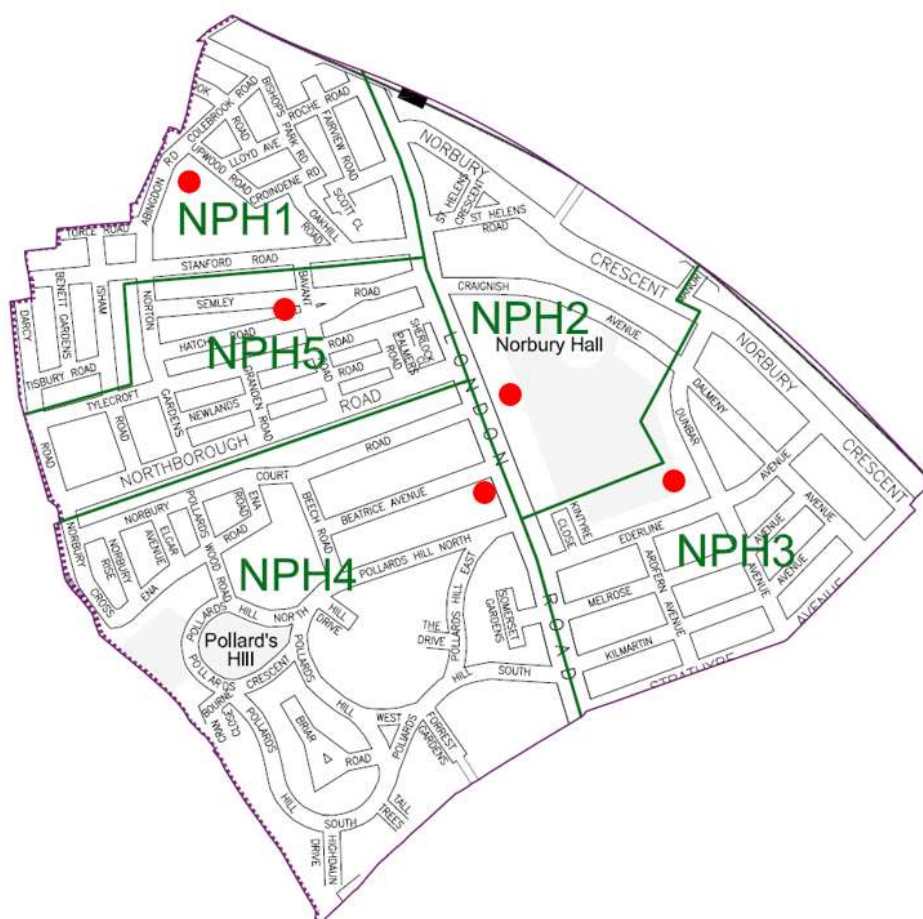

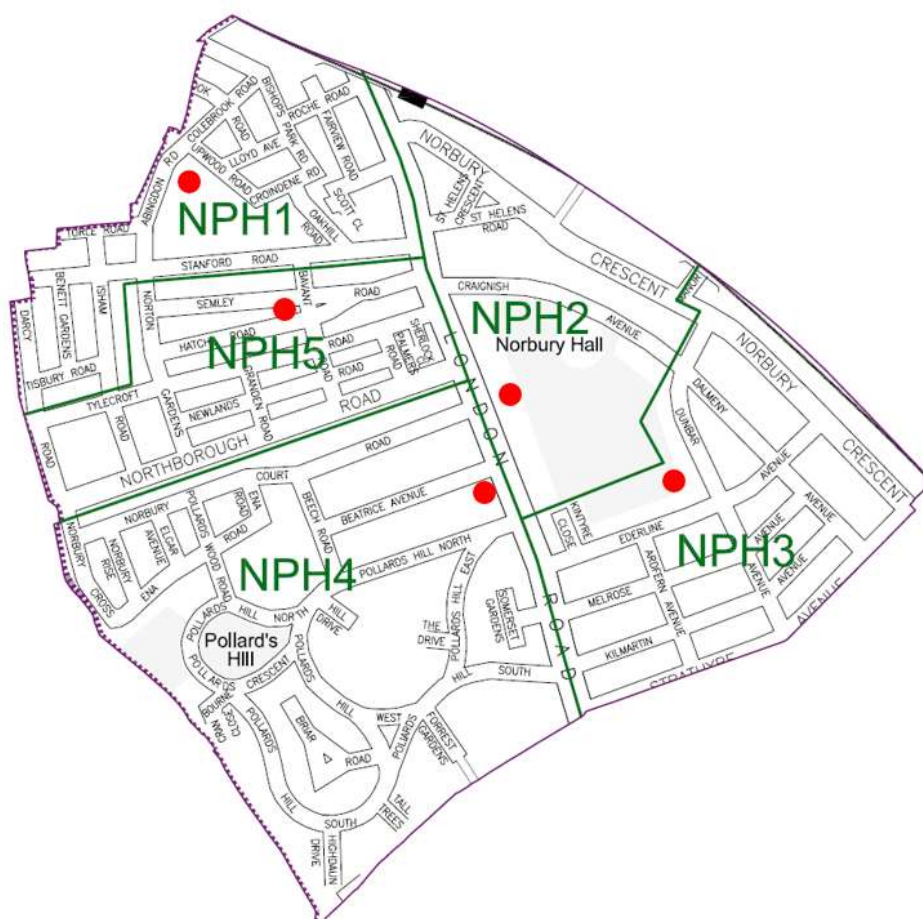
Summary of current arrangements and recommendations:
